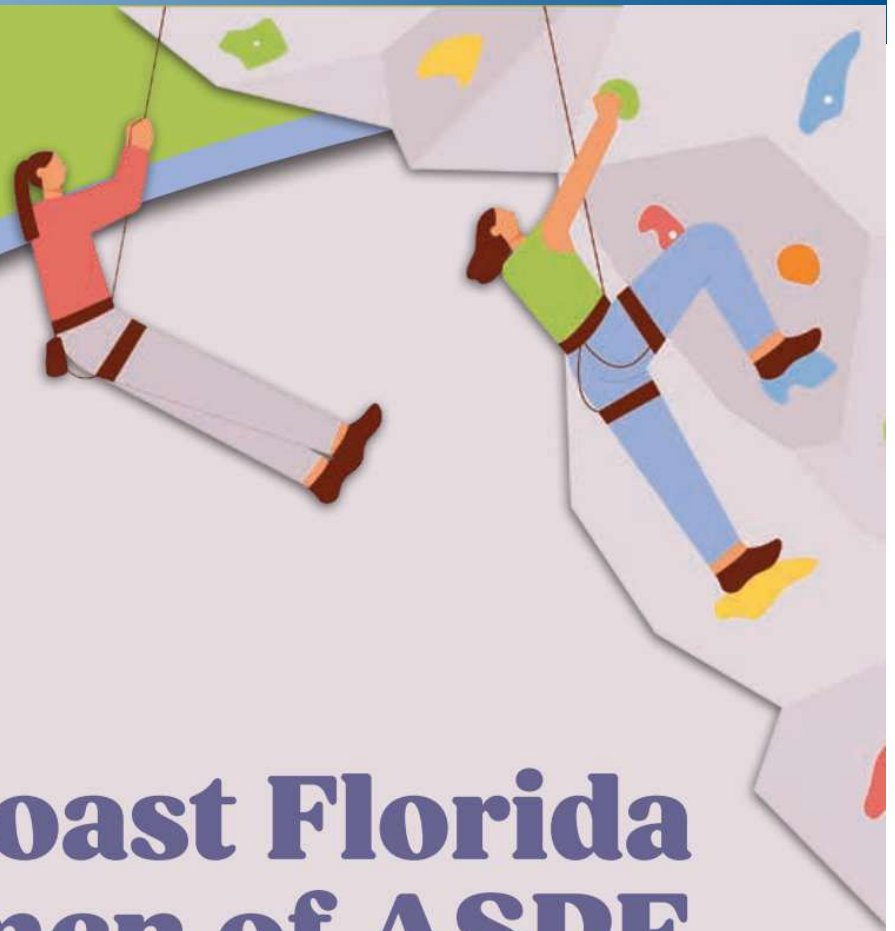

 - Associate's or Bachelor's degree in a field related to engineering (physics, mathematics, architecture, civil, environmental studies, construction, HVAC, etc.) and a minimum of two years of experience designing plumbing systems
 - 4 years minimum of plumbing design experience
 - c) Remote Proctored Exam
 - d) 3.5 hours, 100-question multiple-choice answer
 - e) ASPE Members \$225; Non-members \$450

- 10) 2027 CPD Exam TBD
 - a) 2026 CPD Exam was April 13-24, 2026
 - I know you all did well and I know you are eager for those scores and certifications!
 - b) You must fill out eligibility form to receive a link to register for exam.
 - Full ASPE membership or previously received approval to sit for the exam; or
 - A minimum of four years of experience in a position of responsibility for the design of plumbing systems and possess a bachelor's degree in a field related to engineering.
 - In lieu of an accredited degree, a candidate may substitute up to an additional four years of practical experience in the design of plumbing systems, for a total of eight years, or be granted a credit of one-half year of practical experience for each full year of education in an accredited curriculum related to plumbing engineering.
 - CPDT Certification counts toward one (1) year of experience.
 - c) Remote Proctored Exam
 - d) 3.5 hours, 100-question multiple-choice answer
 - e) APSE Members \$450; Non-members \$675
